



## 2014 USTA National Masters Tournament

### FACT SHEET

#### OVERVIEW

The USTA National Masters Tournament (USTA Level 1) is a singles only event using a new progressive format. The event features 4 players from the 14 and under age division, 7 players from the 16 and under age division, and 14 players from the 18 and under age division.

#### DATES

October 22-26, 2014.

Arrival and check-in is on October 22, 2014

Competition and Camp dates are October 23 – 26, 2014

Departure is Sunday, October 26, 2014

#### LOCATION

The Masters event will be played the USTA Training Center, 10399 Flores Drive, Boca Raton, FL 33428.

The official hotel is the Hilton Suites Boca Raton, 7920 Glades Rd, Boca Raton, FL 33434.

This event will be played on the clay courts of the USTA Training Center

#### FORMAT OF PLAY

- All matches are the best of three tie-break sets. All matches will have a solo chair official using the ITF procedure for a solo chair.
- 4 boys and 4 girls in the 14 and under age divisions shall play in a regular draw (first round losers play a consolation match) on the first day. The winner in each division advances to compete with the players in the 16 and under age division and the remaining 3 stay to train with USTA National Coaches.
- 7 boys and 7 girls in the 16 and under age divisions (plus the 14s division winners) shall play two rounds in a regular draw (first round losers play a consolation match) with the players reaching the finals advancing to compete in the 18 and under division. The remaining 6 stay to train with USTA National Coaches.
- 14 boys and 14 girls in the 18 and under divisions (plus the 16s division finalists) shall play a Compass Draw.

#### HOSPITALITY

The USTA National Masters is a hospitality event. Meals and lodging will be covered by the USTA. Each player will also receive a travel stipend for the event.
